Intimation about the Medical Unfitness of the Candidates

1. Document verification (DV) for LEVEL-6 POSTS under CEN No. 01/2019 was conducted at this RRB on 05/01/2023. Candidates whose DV was successful were sent for Medical examination at the nominated Railway Hospitals/ Health Units across South Western Railway Jurisdiction.
2. The list of candidates who are UNFIT in A2 medical categories is given below.
3. Candidates who have been found unfit in the prescribed medical category for LEVEL-6 POSTS, have the option to prefer an appeal.
4. Candidates who desire to prefer appeal against the decision of the Railway Medical Authority may submit the same in the attached Proforma, with relevant documents mentioned below, to the Chairman, Railway Recruitment Board, Bengaluru before 18.00 hours of **28-02-2023**. They should submit the appeal by Registered post /Speed Post only.
5. Temporary Unfit candidates are required to report to Railway Recruitment Board office, Bangalore after undergoing necessary corrective procedure as advised by the Medical Authorities.
6. **After attending DV, those candidates who have not attended medical exam / absconded or absented willfully or not completed medical examination by the nominated medical committee for review, are not eligible for appeal.**

Procedure for Appeal

The appeal will be entertained only if:-

1. The candidate produces a certificate in the attached prescribed format (Proforma A) from a Government/Private Doctor of the specialty/specialties in which the candidate has been found unfit.
2. Such certificate should contain a note that the Government/Private specialist is fully aware of the physical and visual standards set by the Railways for the particular medical category, and that he is aware of the fact that the candidate has already been declared unfit according to these standards during medical examination conducted by an appropriate medical board.
3. The certificate should bear the photograph and mark of identification of the candidates duly attested by such a Government/private medical issuing authority duly mentioning its MCI/State registration number.
4. Candidate will be required to pay Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) through Demand Draft payable in favour of Chairman / RRB, Bengaluru.
5. Where PCMD is of the opinion that there should be re-examination of the case of appeal, he may nominate a medical board to re-examine the candidate. The decision of PCMD, South Western Railway on the appeal preferred by the candidates will be communicated to them through RRB/Bengaluru.
6. In case, the decision changes from unfit to fit, the amount of Rs. 1000/- submitted through DD will be returned to the candidate. In all other cases, the DD amount will be forfeited and the candidates will not have any claim on the same.
7. After this appeal no further chance will be given for medical examination.

NOTE: 1) Appeal against the medical unfit should be sent in his / her own handwriting with signature. 2) The proforma 'A' should contain detail diagnose particulars (both with glasses and without glasses for visual standards). 3) The appeal will be entertained only with the appeal letter as given at Proforma B, Original Medical certificate as given at Proforma A & DD for Rs. 1000/-

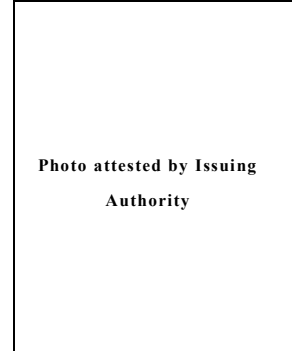
